Recently Published New Titles -

LEEDS TO HARROGATE

including Otley, Wetherby, Pilmoor and Poppleton (towards York) Mark Kelly

Of the railway routes covered in this book, only the line from Leeds to York via Harrogate remains open. Although this is largely operated as a single entity, its two sections differ enormously. The section from Leeds to Harrogate is still very much a main line, hosting services to and from King's Cross, whilst the section from Harrogate to York is partially singled and features semaphore signals and manually operated level crossings. This section was also proposed for closure in the Beeching Report, but permission was not granted.

Of the other routes covered, Arthington to Otley and Leeds to Wetherby were victims of Beeching, whereas the line from Knaresborough to Pilmoor closed to passengers as early as 1950, closing completely in 1964.

CARDIFF TRAMWAYS

Colin Barker

Railed public transport served the citizens of Cardiff for just over 77 years, first using horse power, and subsequently electric traction. This publication provides a photographic record of the trams and the routes they served, illustrating how the city's street scenes and citizens' lifestyle have changed over the years. Whilst the contents will be of interest to transport enthusiasts, it will provide material for those studying the social history of the city.

Until the opening of the Forth Bridge in 1890, passengers from Edinburgh to Fife had to endure crossing the Forth by ferry to Burntisland. With the bridge came a new line from Inverkeithing to Burntisland to join up with the existing line. The Auchtertool line speeded up the transport of coal from the pits to the docks. All are explored herein along with a variety of images to enjoy.

This is the story of Britain's first standard gauge line to be taken into preservation by volunteers that within three years ran its first passenger services in August 1960. Other significant milestones recorded in this album include the literal ground-breaking extension to East Grinstead to connect with the national network, with services running from March 2013 to the initial steaming and running of the newly-constructed replica LBSCR Atlantic *Beachy Head* in 2024. The Railway boasts one of the finest collections of vintage steam locomotives and carriages, many of which were preserved straight out of service from BR, that are appreciatively illustrated throughout.

SETTLE TO CARLISLE COLOUR £22.95

including THE BRANCH TO HAWES Roy Davies

Renowned railway writer, O. S. Nock, described the Settle and Carlisle as 'Britain's Most Spectacular Main Line'. The 73 mile (115km) line runs through remote areas of the Yorkshire Dales and North Pennines boasting no less than 14 tunnels and 22 viaducts either up the Long Drag or down the Eden Valley to Carlisle. The spectacular and often very bleak landscapes along with masterpieces of railway engineering, including the iconic Ribbleshead viaduct, are captured in stunning photographs many in colour throughout this album, where trains are often dwarfed by their surroundings.



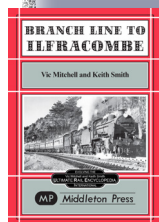
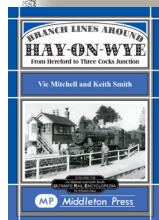
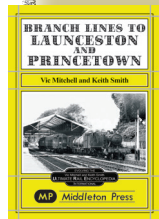
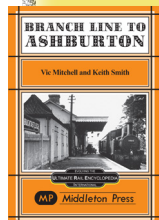
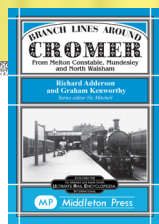
